- Patron: Mrs. Gerlinde Kretschmann






The "Landschaftspark Junge Donau": Location

- Project area within two districts and three counties along the Danube
- From the source in Donaueschingen until Sigmaringen (107 km length)
- Focus on the rural and urban shores of the Danube
- Pushing participant and originator is: city of Tuttlingen, global leader in medical technology











Concept & Goals

- Mobility Improvement of public transport for recreation, tourism and work routes, new connections and paths, development of alternative transport...
- Demography joint solutions for he challenges of the demographic change in the region...
- Recreation & landscape development Improvement of the Danube experience and access to the river, improvement of recreation areas, inter connection of landscapes, development of new retention areas...
- Art, culture and architecture Connection of artistic and cultural events, preservation of historical buildings, promotion of modern architecture....
- Europe to increase the regional awareness, knowledge and educational exchange along the Danube...
- Education & training (new) Cooperation of existing universities, development of academies, development of technical, social and cultural innovations, connection of technic and music...







Thesis

- The base for a successful tourism region is sustainability, which means a balance between ecological, economic and social needs!
- The questions are
 - how to protect and develop the landscape?
 - how to create possibilities of income for the people?
 - how to create and develop possibilities of further education?
 - how to support and develop the local culture and recreation possibilities?







Goal: to establish extensive landscapes, create green jobs, improve mobility, develop the centers of the villages and develop intercommunal work!






Recreation & tourism: Danube Pearls (completed/under way)










Recreation & tourism: Danube Pearls (planned)


